Description

Situated between Asia and Europe, Chelyabinsk is an important trade city that has also a big industrial tradition. The summer school in Chelyabinsk will give the possibility to all participants to touch with hands and live directly life, culture and economy in Russia; that's why it is studied to have a theoretical part and also a practical part. Processes of production and trade relations in Russia are different in confront of Germany and Europe, and the summer school has as goals to show to participants how the situation about these two arguments is today. Participants will take part in lectures, seminars workshops and business-trainings. German and Russian participants will have opportunities to interact and work together. Integration and internationalization are two very important values for the Chelyabinsk State University; for this reason, participants will find a comfortable place full of ideas and reflections, in few words an ideal place where they can enrich their knowledge. Participants will have also the opportunity to know about Russian and Ural culture. The aim of the project is to achieve practical-oriented knowledge about organization of production and trade in Russian companies and overall in economy, and get communication skills in Russian business environment and habitat, more acquaintance about Southern Ural history, nature and modern day. Chelyabinsk is the capital of South Ural, it is a city with more than one million citizens; recently, it became a famous city because of the meteorite that fell down about four years ago. It is fare only two hours from Moscow and every day work ten flights from Chelyabinsk. Chelyabinsk is a multi-ethnic city; Russian community is less than 75% of total population in Chelyabinsk; there is also the German community that actually is more than 1% of citizens, it is smaller than Tatarian, Bashkirian, Ukrainian and Kazakh community but it is bigger than Byelorussian, Armenian, Greek and other communities.

The project is composed by Lectures, Workshops, Discussion and Seminars and in the end a conclusive Conference. The Summer School will start with the lecture "Economic Science in Russia: Heritage and Modern Day", an overview about development of Economic Science in Russia. Then participants will assist to the lecture "Production, Supply and Sales in Russian Companies" and the practical Discussion "Differences Between Germany and Russia in Organization of Work, Production and Trade". In the Summer School, participants will have the possibility to participate also to the Business-training "Making HR-Decisions at Enterprises", an interesting real simulation that helps participants to apply what they studied during Lectures. Then there will be the lecture "Russian Financial Sector", participants will have the opportunity to receive more information about peculiarities of Russian financial system; after that, there will be two workshops: "The System of Modern Russian

Management" and "Main features about Transactions with Russian companies". Participants will assist to the lecture "Corporate Governance in Russia"; then with the seminar "Internal and External Factors of Business Success in Russia and Italy". Then there will be the lecture "International trade and customs regulation in Russia" and the business training "Customs Declaration Process in Russia"; participants will receive instruments to understand how Russian trade is regulated and how it works. In the end, there will be the conference. "Economic relations between European and Russian companies" as conclusive moment of the Summer School.
